The Pilgrimage Church and Michael Pacher Altar

St. Wolfgang’s Pilgrimage Church is special because of its picturesque position overlooking the lake. Built in the 15th century in the gothic style, the church houses an abundance of art treasures. The most famous work of art being the high altar by Michael Pacher (1481), more often than not described as the most beautiful winged altar ever. Towering in the centre of the church is a dominant baroque altar, the double altar of Thomas Schwanthaler (1675). The ‘Man of Sorrows’ by Meinrad Guggenbichler is generally accepted as his greatest and most mature work. This can also be found in the Pilgrimage Church of St. Wolfgang.
